Mr. Walker:

When you have business in the Little Rock School District (LRSD) administration building, you are asked to make an appointment with the individual you wish to see. When you enter the building, you are not allowed to free-roam the halls or enter district employees' offices for the purpose of seeking unspecified information.

LRSD employees of the Human Resources Department were harassed and intimidated by you on yesterday, October 29, 2013. This is not acceptable behavior, and it will not be tolerated.

Our front security officer asks all District patrons and other visitors to sign in and state their destination when they arrive in the LRSD administration building. This has been our practice and policy for well over two years. In order to quell further disruptions to the workplace, if you do not have an appointment, you are to see me, Mr. Burton or Mr. Bailey for any requests you might have. If we are unavailable, you may leave a message with Ms. Beverly Griffin and she will get the message to the appropriate person for a response.

Further, when you submit Freedom of Information Act requests, we will continue to make every effort to gather the information and provide it to you in a timely manner. We will notify you when the information is available, and you may pick it up or send one of your representatives to pick it up. We can also make arrangements to have the information delivered to your office if that is an option for you.

I have been apprised of the past history dating back to 2001 of your characteristically unpleasant, unethical, and unprofessional contact with employees of the Little Rock School District. We do not accept this type of behavior towards our employees, our students, or other patrons of the LRSD. We will not allow this to continue. It is disruptive to the workplace environment and cannot be tolerated.

I would appreciate your cooperation.
