



FACTS CONSTITUTING REASONABLE CAUSE

NARRATIVE: The Arkansas State Police received information from the Independence County Sheriff's office regarding a complaint against Arkansas State Police Corporal Mark Holland. The complaint indicated Skylar Galloway had received a letter via United States Postal Service. The letter was post marked November 30, 2019. The letter had a return address were Galloway previously resided. The author of the letter stated that they had strong feelings for Galloway and that they were willing to spend money for pictures of Galloway. The author of the letter requested that Galloway reply to the email addresses "thrillseeker85@protonmail.com" or "realdeal3055@protonmail.com."

During an interview with Galloway, she indicated that she had received numerous anonymous emails from the email addressed mentioned above. Galloway provided copies of approximately twenty-three emails that she had received since April 2019. She stated that she had been receiving the emails since March 2016. The author of the emails stated that they wanted to preform sexual acts with Galloway and wanted to pay Galloway for nude photos of herself. Some of the emails contain sexual related requests. In one email in particular, the author says that "if I have to come over there, I'll take my own pics. I'm going to get what I want." When Galloway was asked why she believed it was Holland that sent the letter and email, she says that Holland sent had previously sent her a message on Instagram stating "damn girl, you sure lost all that baby weight." She also stated that she believed it was Holland because due to Holland being in law enforcement, he could access her information. Galloway was previously employed at a gas station that was owned by Holland's family. She stated the email began approximately one month after she stopped working at the gas station. Galloway stated that her lifestyle has changed due to the harassment. She said that it has caused her to fear for her and her family's life.

During a post-Miranda interview, Holland was presented with some of the emails that Galloway received. He stated that he sent the emails and the letter to Galloway. He told me that he sent approximately fifty email over a three-year period. Holland was able to locate Galloway's email from Facebook. Holland says he mailed the letter after Thanksgiving and that he was able to located her address by accessing the Arkansas Crime Information Center/National Crime Information Center (ACIC/NCIC). Holland told me the he accessed the ACIC/NCIC system multiple times to obtain information about Galloway. A check of the ACIC/NCIC revealed that Holland accessed Galloway's information at least eighteen times since 2016. When Holland was asked if he has approached

Galloway's residence, he stated that he has driven by her residence multiple times while in his marked State Police vehicle. He says he did this to determine if Galloway was at home. Holland told me that he believed the email he sent that stated "on the other hand, if I have to come over there, I'll take my own pics. I'm going to get what I want" was threatening to Galloway. The email also stated "you are going to scream and moan, but you probably won't really like it".

Holland stated he was infatuated with Galloway and the he fantasized about her. Holland told me that he also sent emails to Galloway's husband expressing his infatuation with Galloway. He stated that he was irritated that Galloway did not respond to his emails.

Holland informed me that he recalled receiving an email form Galloway advising him to stop contacting her. He stated that he ignored her and continued to do so. Holland told me that he used the email addresses "realdeal3055@protonmail.com", "thrillseeker85@protonmail.com" and "williedelight@protonmail.com". When asked why he use protonmail, Holland says it is an encryption email service and he did not want to get caught because it would be very embarrassing. Holland also provided a written statement admitting his aforementioned actions.

I requested a search of ACIC's files of Skylar Galloway and family members. The time frame was January 2016 through February 10, 2020. The family members included, Christopher Galloway, Michelle Dorsey, Kylie Dorsey, Mary Dorsey, Marshall Dorsey III, Shelley Dorsey, Lori Galloway and Shawn Galloway. The results are as follows:

- Skylar Galloway was ran in ACIC by Holland seventeen times during the time frame. The dates were February 20, 2016 (2), April 11, 2016, February 19, 2017, September 25, 2017, October 2, 2017, October 24, 2017, April 3, 2018, October 9, 2018 (2), April 12, 2019 (2), April 30, 2019, May 17, 2019 (2) and August 18, 2019 (2).
- The license plate number 420VPB was ran in ACIC by Holland once during the time frame. The date was February 23, 2018. The vehicle is registered to Skylar and Christopher Galloway.
- The license plate number 932TJK was ran in ACIC by Holland three times during the time frame. The dates were December 4, 2018, September 5, 2019 and September 23, 2019. The vehicle is registered to Skylar and Christopher Galloway.
- The vehicle identification number 1G11B5SL9EF179333 was ran in ACIC by Holland once during the time frame. The date was September 23, 2019. The vehicle is registered to Skylar and Christopher Galloway.
- Holland searched ACIC for vehicles owned by Skylar Galloway three times during the time frame. The dates of the searches were April 30, 2019, May 17, 2019 and August 18, 2019.
- Holland searched ACIC for vehicles owned by Christopher Galloway once during the time frame. The date was August 18, 2019.
- Christopher Galloway was ran in ACIC by Holland eight times during the time frame. The dates were April 9, 2017 (2), September 25, 2017 (2), May 17, 2019(2) and August 18, 2019 (2).
- Michelle Dorsey was ran in ACIC by Holland once during the time frame. The date was November 23, 2019. Holland ran the license plate number 139 UTU once during the time frame. The vehicle is registered to Michelle and Marshall Dorsey. Holland issued Michelle a citation of speeding on November 23, 2019.
- Holland searched the name files in ACIC for Shelly Dorsey twice during the time frame. The dates were April 11, 2016 and April 30, 2019.
- Holland searched the names file in ACIC for Shawn Galloway five times during the time frame. The dates were February 20, 2016, October 9, 2018, April 12, 2019, May 17, 2019 and August 2019.

There were a total of forty-two searches conducted by Holland during the time frame mentioned above. Only one search resulted in the issuance of a citation. The citation was issued to Michelle Dorsey on November 23, 2019. This date was seven days before the postmark date of the letter mentioned above. Michelle Dorsey is the step-mother of Skylar Galloway.

When Holland was asked if he has approached Galloway's residence, he stated that he has driven by her residence multiple times while in his marked State Police vehicle. He says he did this to determine if Galloway was at home. I was able to examine global position system history for Holland's marked State Police vehicle. The information indicated that on October 24, 2017, Holland was on Jeffrey Cutoff in Locust Grove at 10:23am. Holland also accessed Skylar Galloway's information via ACIC at the same time. On February 23, 2018, Holland was on Jeffrey Cutoff in Locust Grove at 3:16pm through 3:19pm. Holland ran license plate number 420VPB via ACIC at 3:19pm. On September 5, 2019, Holland was at Jeffrey Cutoff in Locust Grove at 8:08am through 8:12am. Holland ran license plate number 932TJK via ACIC at 8:08am. On September 23, 2019, Holland was at Jeffrey Cutoff in Locust Grove at 8:09am through 8:14am. Holland later ran license plate number 932TJK and vehicle identification number 1G11B5SL9EF179333 at 8:43am.

Holland stated he was infatuated with Galloway and that he fantasized about her. Holland told me that he also sent emails to Galloway's husband expressing his infatuation with Galloway. He stated that he was irritated that Galloway did not respond to his emails. Holland told me that he believed the email he sent that stated "if I have to come over there, I'll take my own pics. I'm going to get what I want" was threatening to Galloway.

Holland informed me that he recalled receiving an email from Galloway advising him to stop contacting her. He stated that he ignored her and continued to do so. Holland told me that he used the email addresses "realdeal3055@protonmail.com", "thrillseeker85@protonmail.com" and "willielight@protonmail.com".

Thrillseeker.

That's who you are to me.

Even now it's hard to separate the man behind the computer from the person I thought you were.

I worked at your family's gas station. I talked to you in passing sometimes. I even asked you what I could do about "my stalker." I trusted you.

It turns out that the person I was asking for advice, was the person I was asking for advice about. I imagine you were probably laughing and thought you had me fooled. Thought that I would never suspect you.

I finally played detective on my own after filing multiple police reports and going on a wild goose chase just to get some help. I'm thankful to myself for never giving up. Because if I had, I would still be where I was- in a really dark place, contemplating and planning my own suicide, just to get away from you.

The constant fear for my own life was exhausting. I never rested. My eyes were always scanning my surroundings, whether I was at home or in public, looking for any signs of you, although I didn't know what I was looking for.

I was in "fight, flight, or freeze mode," as my therapist called it. My body never stopped looking for danger, because my mind believed I was in danger. It wasn't wrong.

You parked less than a mile from my house, at times running my information in the police database. You drove by my house. Who knows if you followed me or peeked into my windows at night. I'll never know. And I don't want to know.

I bought my first gun. Anytime I went somewhere and came home, I locked my kids in the car and put my keys in my pocket so no one could steal them and drive away with my kids. Then I went inside our house with my pistol and did a sweep of our entire home. I checked every room, the closets, under the beds, even behind the shower curtain.

The kids would ask me almost daily if they could play outside and my response was the same- "We can't go outside unless daddy is home, remember?" My kids knew about you. They had been warned about "the bad man," and were prepped for times when he might come and try to hurt us. I told them that mommy was trying to put the bad man in jail so he can't bother us anymore.

My kids' schools were informed. My place of employment was informed. We came up with an emergency plan in case you came in and said something that triggered my brain to know it was you. All it would have taken was for someone to call me "sugar lips," and I would have immediately known, and the emergency plan would have started.

I was escorted by co-workers to and from my car. Once inside my vehicle I would lock all the doors immediately and look in the back seat. That's a habit I never stopped doing, even now.

Family members were also prepped. We had a code word. All I would have to do is text or say this word and they would send the police to my location, which they could access on the tracker app we all had. Just in case, God forbid that we would ever need it.

After almost four years of living in a constant state of terror and panic, my body and my mind were done. The threats got worse and worse. The wording was more descriptive. I couldn't sleep without dreaming of a man breaking in and raping me with a smile on his face. My skin crawled. I was done. I couldn't take it anymore. I thought I would never know who you were so I could tell police and get away from you. There was no hope.

In my mind, it was all my fault that my kids couldn't play outside or go to the park or to the pool. It was my fault I wasn't a happy or fun mom. It was my fault I was always anxious and scared and on edge. I thought if I died, my family could actually LIVE.

So I planned it out. I was going to slit my wrists or shoot myself. I had razors. I had loaded guns. But for some reason, maybe God or maybe for this moment right here and now, I couldn't ever bring myself to do it.

Looking back, after more than a year of therapy and several types of medications, I can see now that none of this was or is my fault. I realized that my family would not thrive without me, whether you were still harassing me or not.

After almost four years of "thrill" for you, thrillseeker85, realdeal3055, williedelight and all the other names you made up for yourself as you hid behind that computer screen, I will not be thrillsought any longer.

I refuse to give you any more of my life. I've come back stronger and more determined to live and thrive for me, my family, and for all of the women in situations similar to mine who never had a voice before it was too late.

Goodbye Thrillseeker, I honestly hope you can make the best life possible out of whatever punishment you receive, and that you come out of this a changed man, not only for you, but for those around you, and for your boys. We all deserve the best version of you.

I wanted to say thank you to the officers that finally took me seriously after filing multiple reports, to the special agent with the state police that went above and beyond, as did the investigators at the Independence County Sheriff's office after I gave them a name, the prosecutor, deputy prosecutor, the victim advocates, and any other people I may have missed. Also thank you to friends and family that supported me during this time, including you all that are here today, my kids and husband for being my light in my darkest hours, and to my sister for making my intake therapy appointment for me. You all helped save my life. I will be eternally grateful.
